## INDIE MUSIC PICK

**HEAD FOR HILL'S:** Tiswas, a label and a weekly event at Don Hill's (511 Greenwich St., at Spring Street; [212] 219-2850) lines up buzz bands weekly. This week is another exceptional night, with local acts the Stills, the Inevitable Breakups, Elefant and the Jupiter Project. The Stills, about to hit a U.K. tour as openers for the Yeah Yeah Yeahs, wear their Brit post-punk movement on its layers of sharp guitars and singer Tim Fletcher's emotive vocals. The band members, originally from Canada, split their time between New York and Montreal, and only have a three-song demo — which you can hear on their site, [www.thestills.net](http://www.thestills.net). The Inevitable Breakups, which performs catchy, harmony-filled indie pop, have a new CD, "No Wonder You're So Beautiful," and features Daniel Stampfel (ex- the Skastafarians). Elefant, about to release the EP "Sunlight Makes Me Paranoid," takes some cues from the British music as well, more on the new-wave rock dance tip, with overtones of Orchestral Maneuvers in the Dark.
